



KNIGHTDALE TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

July 10, 2014

The Knightdale Town Council held a special meeting at 7:00 p.m. at Planter's Walk Clubhouse, 901 Lynnwood Road, Knightdale, North Carolina.

PRESENT: Mayor Russell Killen, Mayor Pro Tem Mike Chalk, Councilors James Roberson, Mark Swan, Dustin Tripp, and Randy Young.

ABSENT: No one.

Staff Members Present: Seth Lawless, Town Manager; Fred Boone, Town Engineer; Katie Griffin, Engineering Intern.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Killen at 7:00 p.m.

Fred Boone presented the Lynnwood Road restriping plan and answered questions from the attendees which included members of the Planter's Walk Homeowners' Association. Concerns were raised by the HOA Board with the restriping plan. They also relayed numerous incidents of speeding. Suggestions included adding stop signs at the Mathews Glen intersection, the Clay Hill intersection, removing the proposed on street parking, and removing the proposed bike lanes. Stephen Morgan of 1001 Japonica Court, as a member of the HOA Board, suggested additional curb ramps at intersections that do not currently have them and sidewalk on the clubhouse side of Lynnwood Rd.
