# NEW PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY

n December of 2018, the Town of Knightdale began construction on a new Public Works Operations Center. The new facility is now open and ready to support the expanding needs of Knightdale residents.

The former Public Works building located on Robertson Street, had approximately 1,500 square feet of space. That small facility allowed the Public Works Department to serve the community for many years, but was not adequate for the growing needs of Knightdale.

The new, energy efficient Public Works facility, located at the intersection of Bozeman Drive and Great Falls Court, includes 12,000 square feet of interior space. The new automotive shop behind the building will contain two vehicle

# WAKE STONE ATHLETIC PARK



f you notice activity on the corner of Forestville Road and Old Crews Road, it is because the Town of Knightdale has begun construction on the new Wake Stone Athletic Park!

Wake Stone Corporation generously donated 50 acres of land to the Town of Knightdale to begin construction of a new Athletic Park. The first phase will include five soccer fields, parking, and restroom facilities. A possible second phase, coinciding with an additional land donation from the Wake Stone Corporation, is projected to add five additional fields.

These fields will be managed and maintained by the North Carolina Football Club Youth (NCFC Youth). NCFC Youth is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization based in Raleigh, NC and the surrounding Greater Triangle. Since 1974, NCFC Youth has been committed to enhancing each player's soccer experience at every level and age of play. Through innovative soccer programming, player development opportunities, and a focus on coaching education, NCFC Youth creates an environment for more than 13,000 players and 800 coaches to grow on and off the field. NCFC Youth operates in collaboration with the North Carolina Football Club, the parent organization of North Carolina FC (USL, Men's Second Division) and North Carolina Courage (NWSL, Women's First Division). The collaboration creates a soccer pyramid from youth recreational leagues up to the highest level of men's and women's professional soccer

As part of this partnership, NCFC Youth will pay for the operating costs and will maintain the facility. The facility is estimated to bring 261,000 visitors per year to Knightdale and generate approximately \$5 million per year in spending at local businesses and restaurants.

Wake County awarded the project a \$1 Million grant in support of construction.

The Wake Stone Athletic Park will be an economic development catalyst site for Knightdale; generating revenue for local businesses and providing an opportunity to showcase Knightdale to families across North Carolina!

# LOOSE LEAF AND YARD WASTE PICKUP

It's Loose Leaf Season and your Public Works Department has been hard at work devising a strategy to make picking up leaves in your neighborhood as simple as possible. Loose Leaf season in Knightdale runs from late October until February. This is in addition to the yard waste pickup which runs year-round. Please use the information below to inform your decisions about yard waste, leaves and the best time and day to have yours out by the curb.

### **▶ LOOSE LEAVES**

Loose-leaf pickup runs late-October through early-February.

Pile your leaves at the curb by 7:30 AM on the first day of your scheduled window.

Your leaves will be removed before the beginning of your next scheduled pick-up window.

### **YARD WASTE**

Yard waste is picked up year-round, even during the loose-leaf season.

Have your clear bag, compostable paper bagged yard waste, or container at the curb by 7:30 AM on Monday. It will be picked up by Friday, each week.

You may use clear leaf bags for your yard waste, compostable paper bags, or you may use a container available at your local hardware store. Full containers cannot exceed 50 lbs. in weight.
