3rd Party Inspections, Testing and Maintenance

The Knightdale Fire Department Fire Marshal's Office implemented an online program for the submittal of fire and life safety system reports. Fire protection and life safety systems are among the most important components in any building to preserve lives, protect property, and enhance firefighter safety. Routine maintenance is critical to ensure systems are ready to protect citizens, first responders, and property throughout our jurisdiction.

The Compliance Engine by Brycer was selected to provide a single point online reporting system. The Compliance Engine is a web-based technology service and analytic suite that will assist the Knightdale Fire Department Fire Marshal's Office proactively drive fire code compliance and ensure a safer community.

The initial implementation phase occurred on September 15th, 2021.
