ORD #10-01-04-003 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF KNIGHTDALE, REGARDING THE ADDITION OF A NEW USE CATEGORY WITH PERMITTED ZONING DISTRICTS, METHOD OF PERMITTING, DEFINITION AND ADDITIONAL STANDARDS FOR SWEEPSTAKES CENTERS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Knightdale has received a petition to amend the Unified Development Ordinance in regard to the addition of a new use category with permitted zoning districts, method of permitting, definition and additional standards for sweepstakes centers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Knightdale Unified Development Ordinance Section 15.15 establishes uniform procedures for amending the text of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the proposed zoning text changes comply with the goals of the Town's Comprehensive Plan because they are reasonable in that they advance the stated objective of influencing and better managing the development of the community and minimizing the conflict between land uses by recognizing a new business innovation and establishing "sweepstakes centers" as a new use that had been heretofore undefined and not allowed; as well as being consistent with the Comprehensive Plan's stated goal of providing balanced and responsible urban design, planning and development, and providing a vibrant and varied local economy which will attract and support a wide diversity of business opportunities and community services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Knightdale, North Carolina:

SECTION 1. That the Unified Development Ordinance of the Town of Knightdale Code be amended to read as follows (notes in italics):

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3.3(II) Sweepstakes Center (MI*) (2.3C(4)I) *Special Use

- 1. Hours of operation shall be limited from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm.
- 2. No more than 20 machines/terminals/computers for sweepstakes operations may be permitted per licensed location.
- **3.** No portion of a lot on which a sweepstakes center is located may be within 500 feet of another sweepstakes center, existing residential dwelling unit, group care facility, day care center, religious institution or school.

Chapter 19: Definitions

Sweepstakes Center 2.3C(4)I: A business enterprise, whether principal or accessory, where persons may play games on on-site machines/terminals/computers that reveal the results of sweepstakes or similar contests associated with the on-site purchase of internet time, phone time, office supply or other retail good; and where redeemable cash sweepstakes awards (government issued coins and bills in hand) in amounts of \$10.00 or more may be received. This definition does not apply to any game or process prohibited by N.C.G.S. §§ 14-304 through 14-309 or to any game regulated by the North Carolina Education Lottery Commission.

SECTION 2. That all laws and clauses of law in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION 3. That if this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of this ordinance which can be given separate effect and to the end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance has been adopted following a duly advertised public hearing of the Town Council and following review and recommendation by the Land Use Review Board.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be enforced as provided in G.S. 160A-175 or as provided for in the Knightdale Town Code.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by Town Council.
