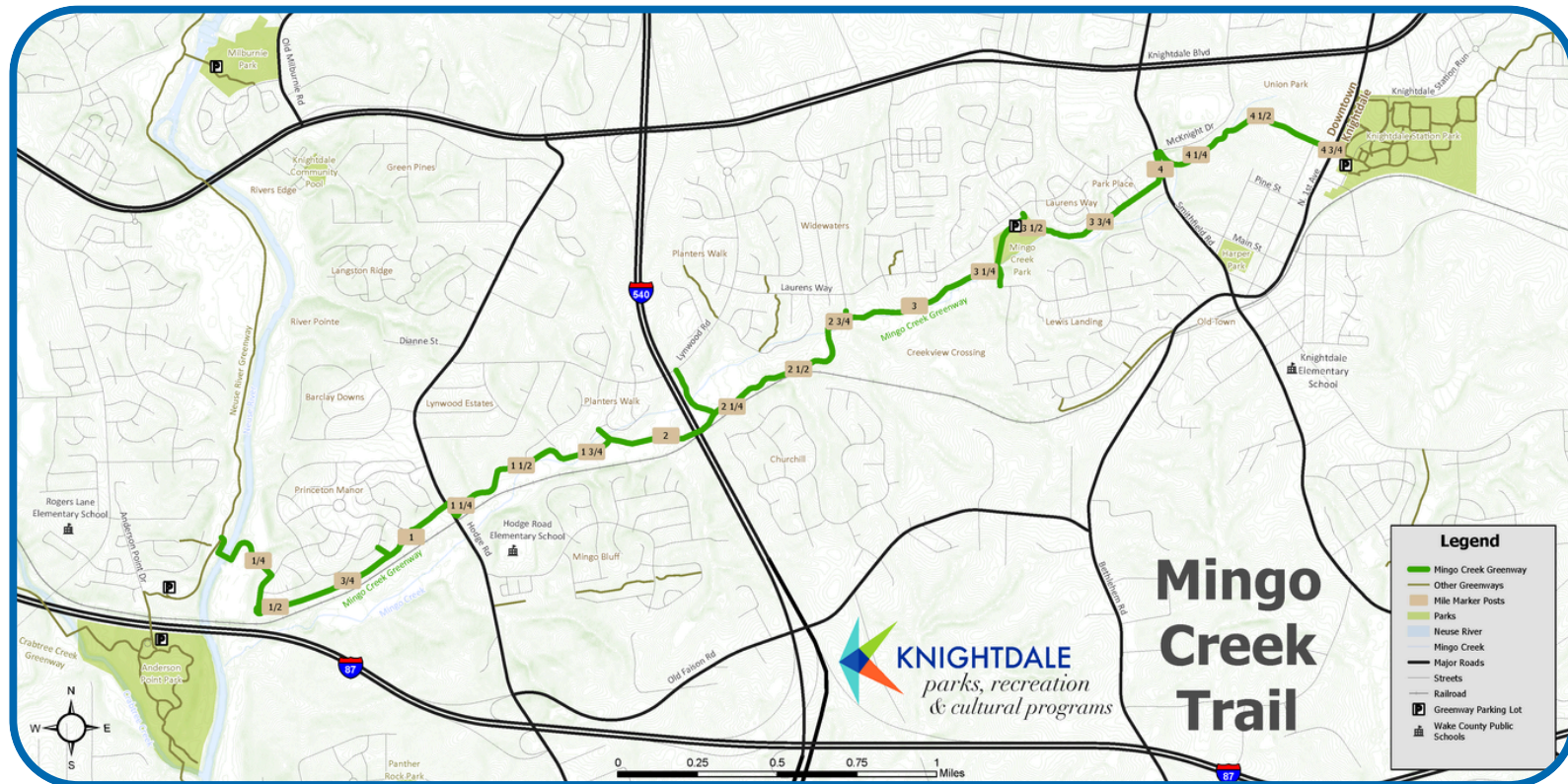

POLICIES

Fee Information

In this guide, you will find that programs have different fees for Town of Knightdale Residents and Non-Residents, written as: \$Residents/\$Non-Residents. Municipal tax revenue is paid to the Town of Knightdale by residents living inside the corporate limits of the Town. Those living outside the corporate limits do not pay Town taxes and therefore are charged a higher rate for participation. Participants must live inside the corporate limits of the Town of Knightdale at the time of registration to receive the Resident rate.

Program Registration & Facility Reservation

Program registrations and facility reservations including indoor facilities, picnic shelters, fields, the cabana, and pavilions may be completed online at Knightdale.RecDesk.com or in person at the Harper Park office.

Athletic program registration deadlines are listed in this program guide. Registration deadlines for all other Town registered programs can be found online at Knightdale.RecDesk.com.

Programs run by partner organizations each have their own registration guidelines, please contact those individual organizations for more information.

Facility rental reservation deadlines are one month in advance for indoor facilities and pavilions, and one week in advance for picnic shelters, the cabana, and field rentals. No facility reservation may be made more than three months in advance.

Inclement Weather & Rained Out Notifications

Knightdale Parks, Recreation, & Cultural Programs utilizes the Rained Out weather notification system to notify parents and participants of delays or cancellations due to inclement weather. The athletics department will go over the Rained Out registration process during seasonal parent meetings. The Wake County Public School System's weather guidelines for closures and activities will also be followed. The Town of Knightdale reserves the right to revise or conduct activities to ensure everyone's safety.

Payment Policy

Knightdale Parks, Recreation, & Cultural Programs accepts cash, check, money order, credit cards including MC, Visa, and Discover as forms of payment. A \$35 service fee will be charged for all returned checks.

For Town registered programs full payment is due at time of registration.

Programs run by partner organizations each have their own payment policies, please contact those individual organizations for more information.

For picnic shelter and cabana rentals, full payment is due at the time of reservation. For indoor facilities, pavilions, and field rentals, full payment is due once the reservation has been approved.

Refund Policy

A full refund will be offered for all programs cancelled by the Town of Knightdale.

For athletic programs refund requests received prior to the ordering of team uniforms will be honored with a full refund. For all other Town registered programs refund requests received at least two weeks prior to the program start date will be honored with a full refund. In the event of injury or other hardship, the Department will evaluate a refund on a case by case basis.

Programs run by partner organizations may each have their own refund policies, please contact those individual organizations for more information.

Facility reservations cancelled at least two weeks prior to the rental are entitled to a full refund. Facility reservations cancelled less than two weeks before the rental are entitled to a refund, minus the deposit. Picnic shelter, cabana, and field rentals are subject to a full refund if inclement weather prohibits use. Recreation Center rentals are not subject to a refund due to inclement weather, unless it results in the closing of the facility.

ART EXHIBITION



The Town of Knightdale presents monthly art exhibitions at Town Hall. The public is invited to view the works of accomplished area and regional artists on display during Town Hall regular public hours and on the Knightdale Parks and Recreation's Facebook page.

Artists working in any medium are invited to submit an application for exhibition. Applications may be submitted at any time at [KnightdaleNC.gov](https://www.knightdalenc.gov). This opportunity is open to any artist or curator seeking to organize a display. Commercial gallery artists are not eligible, although artists represented by a commercial gallery are eligible to apply as an individual. Written proposals for themed exhibitions may be submitted along with artists' images. Works in all disciplines will be considered; however, due to limitations of the exhibition space, artwork that can be hung on the walls must have an attached hanging wire on the back. Artists are responsible for delivery, installation and removal of artwork for exhibitions. Sales will be handled by the artist.

You will be notified after your work has been reviewed. Town of Knightdale specifically reserves the right to prohibit or call for the removal of any or all of an exhibition at any time.
